Maranga Mai e Te Iwi Pakohe, Maranga Mai e Te Iwi Ngāti Kuia

The three Readings of our Settlement Bill is in progress through Parliament. It is anticipated that the final Reading will be sometime in the first part of 2014, and our Ngāti Kuia Act passed into Legislation.

We previously notified Iwi in June 2011, that the best entity to govern our affairs until final Legislation was Te Rūnanga o Ngāti Kuia Charitable Trust.

Because of the continued delays in receiving Settlement and the need to continue Charitable Trust status, all of the current Trustees of Te Rūnanga o Ngāti Kuia Charitable Trust will come to the end of their two year term in office in August 2013.

To comply with the Charitable Trust Deed there is no option but to carry out an election of Trustees.

This will be the final elections for the current Charitable Trust and the term of office will only be until the Post Settlement Governance Entity (PSGE) is activated.

The PSGE Trustees remain current, and will become active on Date of Settlement.
