TE RŪNANGA O NGĀTI KUIA CHARITABLE TRUST

Ngāti Kuia Trust was incorporated on 13 July 1994 as an obligation of the Māori Fisheries Settlement negotiations that required a Mandated Iwi must settle those Assets into a Charitable Trust. The original Trustees were; Elaine Wilson, James (Jim) Walker, Barry Mason, Marie (Dawn) Hart, Tania Hippolite, Peter Hemi, William (Wayne) Hemi and Paata (Hipa) McCready.

Four years later, on 09 June 1998 the Incorporated Society that had been functioning alongside the Ngāti Kuia Trust was closed and a name change was decided to include Te Rūnanga in the Charitable Trust name; Te Rūnanga o Ngāti Kuia Charitable Trust.

This enabled the Trust to carry out "charitable acts" while attracting tax concessions in recognition of this service to the community.

We were required to establish a new post settlement governance entity (PSGE) hence the demise of this Trust to be replaced by Kaikaiawaro Charitable Trust and Te Rūnanga o Ngāti Kuia Trust (the Discretionary Trust – PSGE).

The Trust was maintained to complete some works, namely the Wharekai, so that we could continue to take advantage of the benefits described without complicating matters such as the transfer of functions and assets to the new entity.

It has served us well but we must move confidently into the post settlement structure that better meets our needs. This is proving to be challenging as our entity grows in stature while meeting strict Government requirements.

In closing, we give thanks to the Trustees, Staff, Mandate Holders and Kaumatua who, over time, have contributed to the governance and mahi of Ngāti Kuia, through this entity.
