Te Rūnanga o Ngāti Kuia Trust 2021 Trustee Election

Te Rūnanga o Ngāti Kuia Trust (the Trust) is the PSGE entity created from the Treaty of Waitangi Settlement for Ngāti Kuia. The Trust is governed by seven Trustees, one of whom must retire by rotation later this year and one of whom has retired early. Nominations are now called to fill the pending two vacancies.



The Trust Deed allows a maximum of two trustees at any time to reside outside Te Tauihu (the area within the boundaries of the Marlborough and Tasman District Councils and the Nelson City Council). The candidates for this election cycle do not need to reside within Te Tauihu.

Nominations close at 5pm on Wednesday 6 October 2021. In the event that more than two valid nominations are received, an election will be held amongst registered adult members of the Trust by postal, internet and ballot box voting at the AGM, to be held on Saturday 13 November 2021 at Te Hora Marae, Te Hora Pa Road, Canvastown, Marlborough commencing at 10.30am providing we are at COVID alert level 1 or 2. Online streaming options will be available for COVID levels 3 and 4.
